# **Interviewing 101**

## **Tips to Nail Your Dental School Interview**

- Bring questions and be prepared Research the school and their mission. It is important to emphasize how you align with their mission and how you can make a significant contribution to it once you are accepted.
- It isn't always about your answer, but how you answer Sometimes interviewers will ask an unusual question that feels like it is coming from left field. They aren't looking for a specific answer but instead are observing how you are able to think on your feet and adapt when "caught off guard."
- Share something new Usually interviewers have had an opportunity to look at your application closely (and they will specify if they have not). The interview is a chance to spotlight aspects of yourself that aren't already in your application that can help boost your profile and make you more memorable of a candidate.
- Events you can expect on an interview day Get plenty of sleep, it's going to be a busy day! Expect a welcome from the Dean or admission committee members, tour of the dental school, interactions with faculty and current students, a student panel, and a break down about financial aid. Some schools have a pre-interview day social which is a chance to socialize with current students and other interviewees.

When applying to dental school, it's a good idea to show interviewers that you have been involved in a variety of extracurricular activities that interest you, can relate to the field, and display leadership or teamwork. Some examples of these are:

  - Dental Offices: Explore general dentistry in addition to dental specialities.
  - Dental research
- Working
  - Dental Labs: Including Removable or Fixed Prosthodontic labs, in addition to Orthodontic labs.
  - Dental Office: Working as a scheduler, an assistant, in sterilization, or in radiology.

- Tutoring
- Sports
- Hobbies that show hand-eye coordination
- Greek Life

The most important part of choosing extracurricular activities is that you are passionate about it and that you are comfortable talking about how it helped you become who you are and what you learned from the experience.
